- Mark 14:12

And the first day of unleavened bread, when they killed the passover, his disciples said unto him, **Where** wilt thou that we go and prepare that thou mayest eat the passover?

and saith unto them, Go ye into the city,

bearing a pitcher of water: follow him.

- Mark 14:14,
And wheresoever he shall go in,
say ye to the goodman of the house,
The Master saith, Where is the guestchamber,
where I shall eat the passover with my disciples?

- Mark 14:15,
And he will shew you a large upper room
furnished and prepared:
there make ready for us.

V. THE PERFECT FULFILLMENT OF THE PLANS TO FIND THE PLACE



- Mark 14:16,
And his disciples went forth,
and came into the city,
and found as he had said unto them:
and they made ready the passover.

VI. THE PARTY ARRIVES AT THE PLACE



- Mark 14:17,
And in the evening he cometh with the twelve.

VII. THE PREDICTION OF THE TRAITOR AT THE PLACE



- Mark 14:18,
And as they sat and did eat, Jesus said,
Verily I say unto you,
One of you which eateth with me shall betray me.

VIII. THE PERSONAL RESPONSE OF EACH AT THE PLACE



- Mark 14:19,
And they began to be sorrowful,
and to say unto him one by one,
Is it I? and another said, Is it I?

IX. THE PROXIMITY OF THE TRAITOR TO CHRIST IN THE PLACE



- Mark 14:20,
And he answered and said unto them,
It is one of the twelve,
that dippeth with me in the dish.

X. THE PRONOUNCEMENT OF WOE FOR THE TRAITOR IN THE PLACE



- Mark 14:21,
The Son of man indeed goeth, as it is written of him:
but woe to that man by whom the Son of man is
betrayed! good were it for that man if he had never
been born.

Psalm 41:9,

Yea, mine own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, which did eat of my bread, hath lifted up his heel against me.

LESSONS FOR THE DISCIPLES



1. Trust God's Providential Care for your life!
2. Be responsible to hear His Word, to **“GO”** wherever He tells you to go, and **“FOLLOW”** – obey His every directive/command.
3. Be involved, participate in the work of God, **“MAKE READY FOR US.”**
4. Search your heart for sin, be introspective. If guilty of sin, repent, confess it and seek the forgiveness of God.
5. Do not betray Christ, His Word, His people!
