# Mark 11:1-11 an Allusion to Genesis 49:10-11



- Genesis 49:10 The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be.
- Genesis 49:11 Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes:

- Mark 11:2-3,  
And saith unto them,  
Go your way into the village over against you:  
and as soon as ye be entered into it,  
ye shall find a colt tied, whereon never man sat; loose  
him, and bring him.

And if any man say unto you,  
Why do ye this?  
say ye that the Lord hath need of him;  
and straightway he will send him hither.

# III. THE ENTRANCE INTO A ROUNDABOUT



- Mark 11:4-6

And they went their way,  
and found the colt tied by the door without in a place  
where two ways met; and they loose him.

And certain of them that stood there said unto them,  
What do ye, loosing the colt?

And they said unto them even as Jesus had  
commanded: and they let them go.

# LESSONS FOR THE DISCIPLES



1. Jesus has the right to send His disciples on any mission.
2. Jesus gives specific instructions to His disciples to obey.
3. Jesus knows everything ahead of you in life: the cities, the people, the animals, the details. Jesus is all-knowing, because He is God.
4. Jesus' Word can be trusted and followed.
5. Everything we own we should be willing to give to the Lord to be used in His service.

# Lessons for the Disciples



6. We should worship the King. We should prepare the way for the Lord.
7. We should sing His praises!
8. Our temple belongs to Jesus. Take care of it!
9. Jesus inspects our temple (i.e. body, person, life) at all times and knows what needs to be cleansed from it.
10. Jesus was on a schedule each day.
